

CADD Technician

Requirements:

- Two-year technical degree or certificate of completion from an accredited designer/drafter course (or equivalent);
- Candidates must have 3+ years of AutoCad experience producing 2D and 3D shop and project drawings;
- Must be proficient in Microstation V8 2004 or XM edition;
- Must have a creative mindset and a diverse project background.
- Successful candidate must show experience working the Senior Technician and Engineers to collaborate while utilizing CAD programs.

Responsibilities:

Drafting candidates may make final drafts of proposed drawings; check the dimensions of parts and materials to be used, the relation of one part to another and the relation of various parts to the whole structure or project. The CADD Technician will be responsible for, among other things:

- **E-File Organization,**
- **Review/QC Projects,**
- **Correction to Comments,**
- **Draft Preliminary Design for Proposal,**
- **Draft Projects Per FDOT Requirements.**
- **Timeline Projects To Have Adequate Time For Draft/Design Procedure**
- **Organize Drawings**
