

Job Description – CEI Asphalt Plant Inspector

POSITION OVERVIEW / RESPONSIBILITIES:

Professional Services Firm seeking to fill a full-time Asphalt Plant Inspector position. As an Asphalt Plant Inspector, you will be ensuring that asphalt produced for Florida roads by paving contractors meet quality standards of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). This position involves inspecting the asphalt plant, testing the asphalt produced, and ensuring the contractor performs all required testing as well. As such, Asphalt Plant Inspectors are based at various asphalt plants while asphalt production is occurring. While tasks vary throughout the day, you would primarily be responsible for...

- Inspecting the asphalt plant to ensure compliance with FDOT specifications.
- Testing the asphalt produced to ensure compliance and quality.
- Tracking the total quantity of asphalt produced.
- Reporting test results in a timely manner.
- Assembling testing data into paper lot packages in accordance with FDOT guidelines.
- Effectively communicating and sharing test results and production details with contractors, project managers, engineers, and FDOT personnel.
